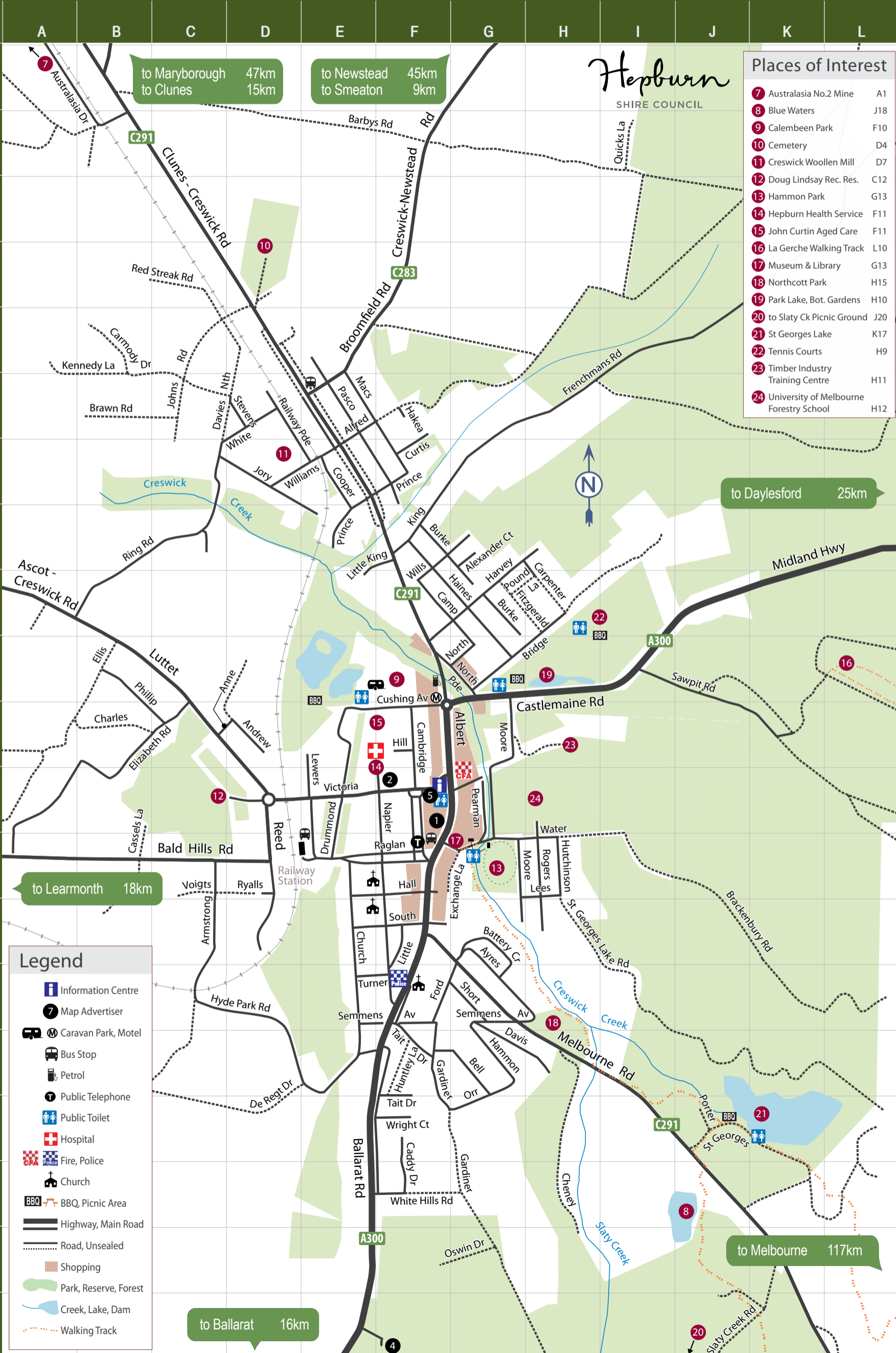


Creswick
